- 1. Sydney Jewellery School take no responsibility for loss or damage and reserves the right to refuse any items which we feel may cause problems.
- 2. It is your responsibility to provide all required information regarding the clay brand and it's firing schedule. Failing to do so may result in your items being fired incorrectly.
- 3. Firings will only be done when the kiln is full. If the firing is required urgently, the whole kiln can be hired and the full kiln rate will be applicable.
- 4. Full payment is due when dropping off your pieces for firing. We accept cash and credit card. Your pieces will not be fired until full payment is received.
- 5. When firing glazed items, the base and 5mm from the base of the pieces must be free from glaze.
- 6. Your pieces must be boxed or contained together, clearly labeled with your name and contact number or your pieces may not be returned to you.
- 7. All pieces left at Sydney Jewellery School for longer than 2 months will incur storage charges. Pieces remaining after 3 months will be disposed of.
- 8. In the event that your pieces cause any damage to Sydney Jewellery School's kiln and / or kiln shelves, you will be liable for any replacement costs. In order to prevent damage, ensure that the firing range given for clay and glazes is correct and that you do not have any other medium accidentally or purposely embedded in your clay.
